

**CITY OF MADEIRA BEACH**  
**Board of Commissioners Workshop Minutes – Part II**  
**Friday, July 29, 2011**

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A Workshop Meeting of the Madeira Beach Board of Commissioners was held on Friday, July 29, 2011 in the City Hall Auditorium, located at 300 Municipal Drive, Madeira Beach, Florida.

Mayor Travis Palladeno called the workshop to order at 6:35 p.m. All commissioners were present.

**1. TOPIC:**

**A. BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS DISCUSSION OF CITY MANAGER CANDIDATES  
FOLLOWING PANEL INTERVIEWS**

Commissioner Lister and Mayor Palladeno said that they were impressed with all three candidates. After a brief overview of the candidates, Commissioner Lister stated that his top pick was Peter Lombardi, whereas Vice Mayor Reynolds' top choice was Kenneth Hurst. Commissioner Vander Velde and Commissioner Oakley both indicated James Sundermeier as their first pick, Kenneth Hurst their second, and Peter Lombardi the third. Mayor Palladeno also chose Mr. Sundermeier.

Upon the request from Mayor Palladeno, City Attorney Trask spoke on the two agreements received from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) regarding the crosswalk at Gulf Blvd and 129<sup>th</sup> Ave. He said that the first agreement received was called the Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement, which gave the city the authority to maintain the facility that was otherwise be maintained by FDOT; whereas the second agreement was basically a contract agreement that gave the city the authority to build the light fixtures on FDOT properties. City Attorney Trask informed the Commission that the second agreement was ready to be considered during the Special Meeting following the workshop at 7:00 p.m. Interim City Manager Mallory said that should the Commission approve the agreement, the lights would be installed within a week.

**2. ADJOURNMENT**

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:46 p.m.
